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Mission

Ayeyarwaddy International School serves preschool to Grade 12 students as an academic institution dedicated to the development of creativity and the enhancement of quality of life, producing educated and self-directed individuals.

The School Community

AIS is a Pre-K through Grade 12 independent, privately owned, co-educational institution serving the international and internationally-minded community of Mandalay, Myanmar, since 2012. Overall enrollment is 1,100 students from Nursery to grade 12, and the high school division has approximately 200 students enrolled for the 2024-2025 school year. AIS will have 42 students in its seventh graduating class in May 2025.



Faculty

The high school faculty consists of 18 full-time Lead Teachers, 24 Assistant Teachers, 8 Elective Teachers, 1 Athletic Director, 1 Curriculum Coordinator, 2 School Counselors, 1 Head of School, 1 Principal, and 1 Deputy Principal. Our foreign hired faculty members include teachers from more than 26 countries, including USA, Canada, U.K, Australia, South Africa, India, France, Greece, Spain, the Philippines, Ghana, Thailand and more.

AIS is fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). AIS is a member of the East Asian Regional Council of Overseas Schools (EARCOS) and affiliated with the College Board and WIDA Consortium.

COVID-19 Statement

Due to COVID-19, learning at AIS was asynchronous from March 12, 2020 to May 31, 2020. Students continued to complete work asynchronously while attending school on campus. During the 2021-2022 academic year, virtual learning was fully synchronous. Between the beginning of the pandemic until June 2022, students were unable to complete co-curricular activities and take standardized tests such as the SAT and the TOEFL. However, AIS fully reopened on August 1, 2022 with face-to-face instruction with full co-curricular activities.

Curriculum

All students follow a rigorous, standards-based, US Common Core curriculum. Students must complete 24 total credits to graduate with their American High School Diploma. As of 2024, all Myanmar nationals are required to take Myanmar language classes. As a result, we added an additional foreign language credit. The 2024-2025 track for all students is as follows:
